


Learning Objectives

- 1. Numeracy: Students will be able to subtract single-digit numbers using Wizbot.
- 2. Literacy: Students will be able to understand and apply subtraction concepts using numerical symbols.

Story

Cling clang...Dhoom Dham...plays the drum in the jungle. Today is the day to play musical fruits. Shim sham smash smoosh...Montu places five fruits in a line.

Woo hooo...Here comes all the animals.

"Let's start!" exclaims Maruti.

The elephant plays the drum.

Stomp stomp...Six animals run around the fruits. The drum stops.


Five animals take one fruit each. The koala gets out.

Now, there are four fruits left. Maruti keeps four fruits in a line.

The koala takes one fruit away **angrily**. Now, there are only three fruits for five animals.

Montu finds one more fruit. He adds it to the line. Now, there are 4 fruits for five animals and the game continues.

Exercise

- B. Place the number cards on the table in a line. Subtract and take the Wizbot to the answer.
